CHANGES TO FOOD BANK OPERATIONS EFFECTIVE 3/26/2020

EFAA is dedicated to ensuring that people facing food insecurity can continue to access critical food assistance through our food bank throughout the coronavirus pandemic. In order to prevent any possible spread of COVID-19 in our food bank and ensure we are able to continue services, EFAA is changing our food distribution hours as of Thursday, March 26th. These new hours will give EFAA's food bank more time to prepare grab and go food bags, sanitize the food bank, and ensure the health and safety of our staff and participants.

Wednesday: 12:30 – 4:30
Thursday: 2:00 – 6:00
Friday: 12:30 – 4:30
Saturday: Closed
Sunday: Closed

How to Get Help:

- EFAA's food bank will be distributing grab-and-go food bags on the north side of our main office at 1575 Yarmouth during the above hours.
- Bags contain non-perishable items, including vegetarian items, that will vary based on availability.
- There is no need to schedule an appointment to use the food bank
- Eligible households are able to pick up food once per week at our food bank.
- You will be asked to provide your name, date of birth, zip code and phone number.
- Food re-evaluations are being extended for six months.
