Cheryl works hard in her job as a substitute teacher, yet she needed help covering the cost of orthotic shoe inserts and brakes for her vehicle — both essential items for her ability to stand all day and travel safely to work. EFAA's Basic Needs team provided her with financial assistance to help her cover these needs. During their visit, her case manager also connected Cheryl with a resource to provide a new furnace that would heat her house during the winter months.

Keri is a survivor of domestic violence who lives with disabilities and other health issues. She moved into EFAA's three-month short term housing and made huge strides during her time in the program, managing to start a savings plan, get a full-time job, a federal housing voucher, and a place of her own to rent. Keri plans to go back to school and create a YouTube channel to empower other women to tap into resources she found along with the process for applications.



Angela is a single mom who went through a difficult custody battle for her daughter. While she now has full custody, the legal fees have created financial hardship for the family. Angie works 60-hours a week, but she is still strained to cover rent some months. Through Keeping Families Housed, a program that offers families extended rental assistance tied to completion of essential investments in family wellbeing, EFAA was able to help Angela's family with several months of rent assistance. With stabilized housing and more money available to cover other expenses, Angela and her daughter can enjoy some peace of mind as they embark on their new chapter.
