# Food Bank Information

## WHAT?

EFAA seeks to provide fresh produce, meats and other grocery staples as well some personal care items to **complement** the goods that households can purchase. Variety and availability varies depending on donations and supply.

## WHO?

Low-income people living in the **City of Boulder and Mountain Communities of Boulder Valley School District (BVSD)** with access to a kitchen may qualify to receive food from our food bank.

## WHEN?

EFAA's Food Bank is open Monday through Friday. **Hours of operation:**

- Monday / Wednesday / Friday from noon - 4.30pm
- Tuesday / Thursday noon -7pm

Households can shop in the food bank **twice per month**

## WHERE?

The Food Bank is located at **16th & Yarmouth in North Boulder** along the SKIP and 204 bus lines. Our address is 1575 Yarmouth Ave, Boulder, CO

## HOW?

Complete your intake paperwork in person:

- Bring a **picture ID and proof of residency** in the City of Boulder or Boulder Mountain Communities (either a current lease or a utility bill within the last 3 months)
- **Reservations** for shopping are not required but are highly encouraged
